

I. Charlotte Hill. — April 11th 1836
Joseph Hill, name of the Mother Elizabeth Hill, maiden name Waters. — Mr. Waters in the craft her Mother's cousin. 2. The Father kept the Plumbe of Feathers in Gloster Lane. 3. The Father died the 11th October 1832; the Mother died June 1832 (Our servant Sally knows the parents, — sat up with them) 4. The child was born in Landings Buildings in St Philips Parish — her name is Charlotte Hill. — On the 7th of Feb^r the child was born, now eleven years old. She lived until this day April 11th at the Plumbe of Feathers, Gloster Lane in the house of her grand father Joseph Hill. 5. The mother at the time of the Bristol riots put out £300 without telling her husband where she had put it, was suddenly taken ill in the Erisepeulus, insensible, and died without telling where the money was, which seems to have caused the Father's death. — 6. Have no property. — There are two children more. The child was put to Yveon School until she could be received into the Orphan-house.
